Delrin® 900P is a general purpose low viscosity acetal homopolymer for multicavity and thin wall moulding with improved processing thermal stability and low VOC emissions.

Injection molding

Drying is recommended, but not necessary for newly opened packaging stored in a dry location.

Follow the drying guidelines above in the following cases:

- If moisture is above the Processing Moisture Content recommendation,
- When a resin container is damaged,
- When the material is not properly stored in a dry place at room temperature, or
- When packaging stays open for a significant time.

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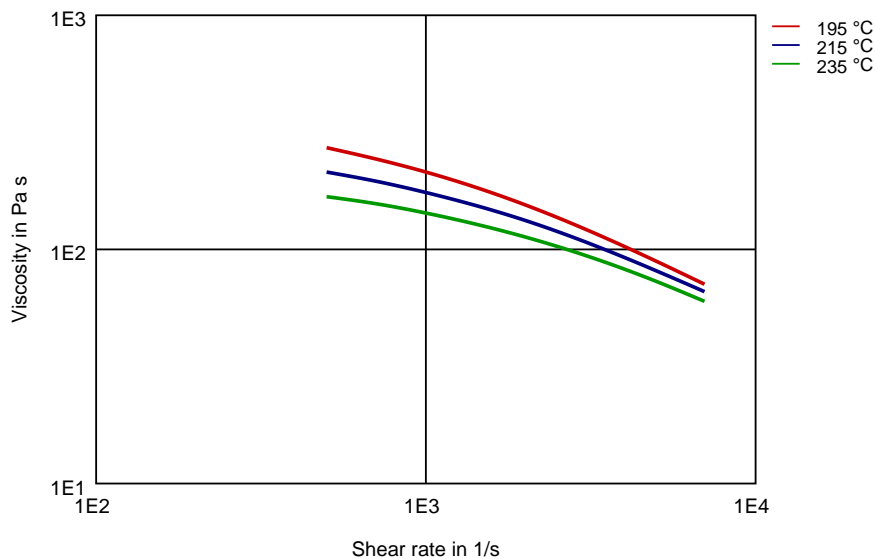


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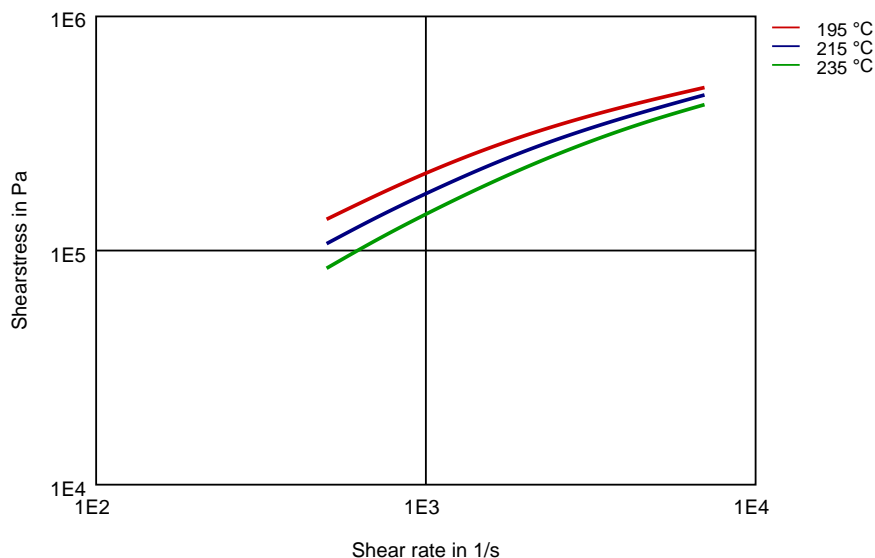

Viscosity-shear rate



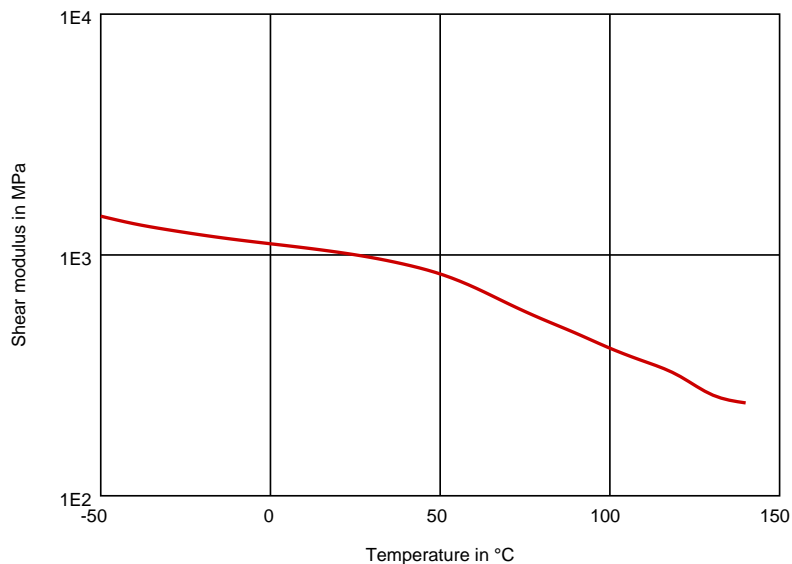
Shearstress-shear rate



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Dynamic Shear modulus-temperature



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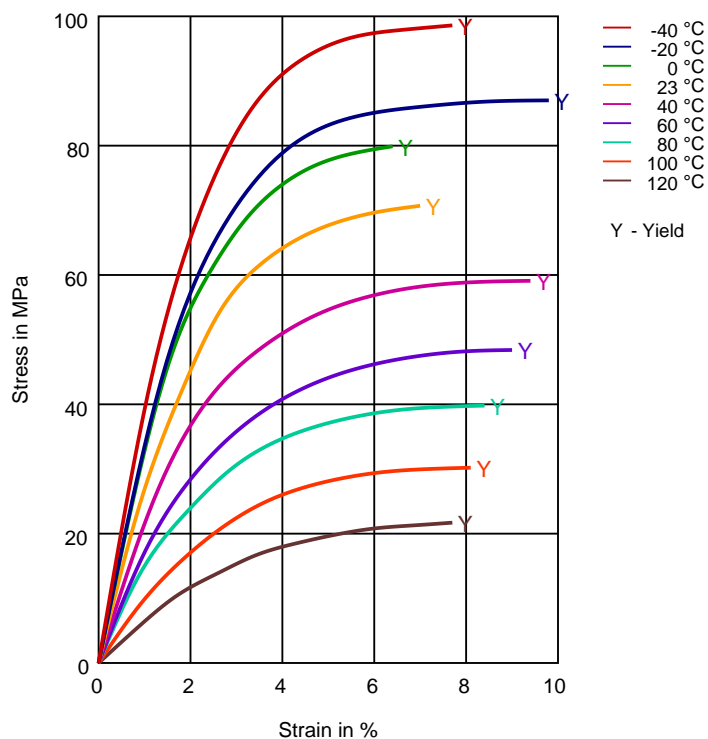
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Stress-strain



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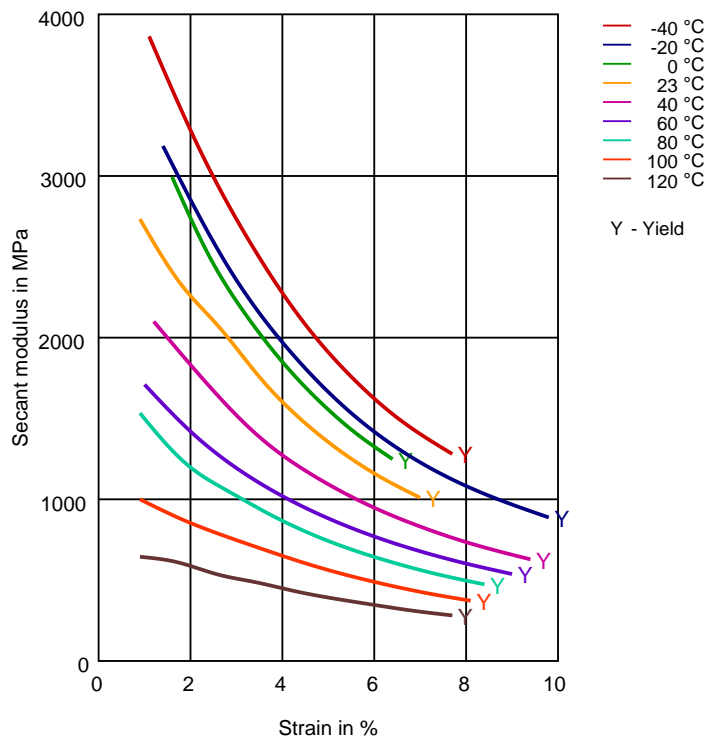
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Secant modulus-strain



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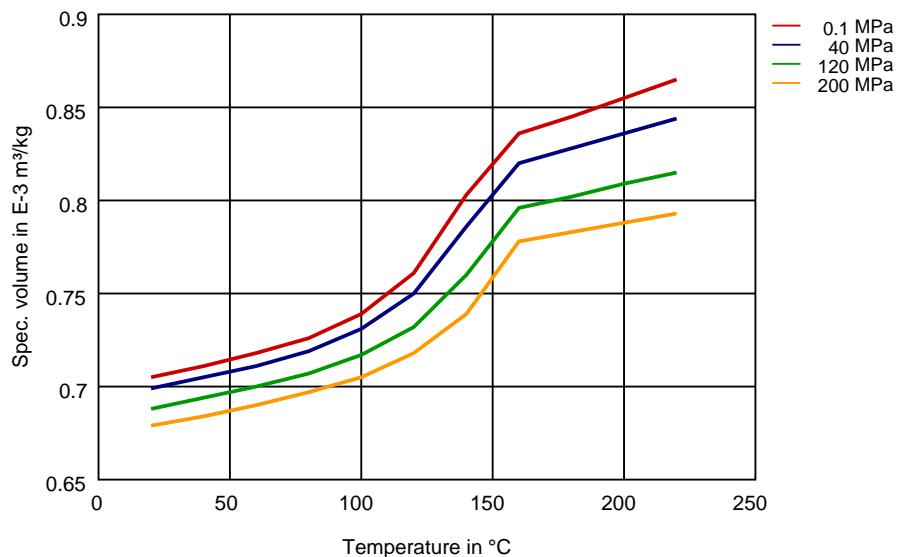
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Specific volume-temperature (pvT)
